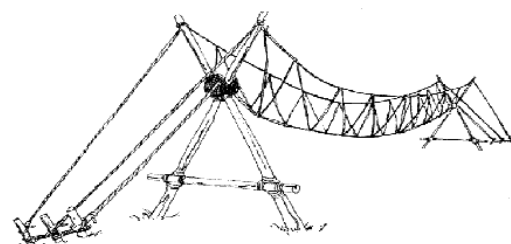




Presented by St. Mary's Boy Scout Troop 109

I understand that participant will be exposed to natural hazards such as insects, wild animals, fire, standing and flowing water, and New England weather. Knowing all this, and accepting all risks, I do hereby give my approval of their participation. I assume all risks and hazards related to the conduct of all activities, and do further release, absolve, indemnify and hold harmless the Boy Scouts of America, Western Massachusetts Council, Chartered Scouting Units, St. Mary's Parish, the sponsors, the property owners, equipment providers, scouts and adult leaders of participating Boy Scout Troop and Venture Crews, any and all of them.

In the event I cannot be reached in an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician, selected by an adult leader in charge, to treat in any manner that the physician deems necessary to secure the health and well being of participant, including, but not limited to, medical or surgical intervention and/or hospitalization, except as noted as below:

Registration Instructions:

Please register by 8PM Thursday, October 31st so that we can make sure we have the appropriate amount of roadkill and other supplies. You may register or get more information online at www.SurvivormanAdventure.info or you may call Troop 109 at (413)454-4615. Please leave a message if you get voice mail. Please do not register if you are not going to attend, and please do not show up without registering. We are trusting you to make sure we have the right amount of food. You must bring this completed registration form with you to the check-in desk or you will not be allowed to enter the facility. Adults are welcome and encouraged to stay for the day. All youths must have a designated responsible adult on-site for the day. Adults can be responsible for groups of up to 8 youths. We need a registration form from all adults who will be staying on-site so that we have emergency contact information if needed. Groups of up to 8 may register, check-in, and check-out together. Check-in will start at 8:30AM. If you must leave early, please check-out before leaving the facility so that we have an accurate headcount throughout the day.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS: We expect all participants to follow the safety rules that will be explained at each event. We expect all participants to treat the volunteers, leaders, and each other respectfully. We expect all participants to protect the natural resources at the facility, and to dispose of trash in appropriate containers. We want everyone to have fun, but our top priority is safety. You will be asked to leave if you behave inappropriately.
